

TRANSCRIPT**ORANGE/FRANCE TELECOM – MOBILE WORLD CONGRESS 2008,
BARCELONA**

The following is an English translation of a transcript of a video made during the Mobile World Congress 2008 in Barcelona. Laurence Thouveny and Yves Tyrode were interviewed for a video on the UMA Innovation Awards.

Laurence Thouveny, Home Zone Program Director, Orange/France Telecom

“The UMA standard is a technology used in mobile telecommunications. UMA gave us the ability to launch a new offer called UNIK, available in France, Spain, Poland and the UK. UNIK is based on a dual-mode phone (Wi-Fi and GSM) which can be connected to our customer’s LiveBox. This connection allows the customer to take advantage of a special rate for unlimited home voice usage. The concept is very simple: the customer buys a UNIK package (handset + subscription), and connects the handset to the LiveBox, which only needs to be done once. That’s all.

Then, within the personal Wi-Fi coverage area – the ‘homezone’ created by the LiveBox – the customer can benefit from a specific rate and unlimited voice calls when at home. Thanks to UMA, we have been able to design a service based on a fixed-mobile convergence approach. Today UNIK is the most attractive solution proposed by France Telecom in terms of FMC, which demonstrates the strong positioning of Orange as a converged operator.”

“UMA is the first technology created to link the broadband and mobile universes. It is now a standard technology, more attractive than a proprietary approach, and is very scalable. We started with a broadband/voice solution, UNIK, and in 2008 we will see the launch of numerous new services, like a TV service on UNIK handsets, the ability to send pictures when you arrive at home, etc. In short, we’ll see the arrival of multi-media and data services on your phone at home. Doing so, I hope that Orange will be recognized once again by the market as an innovative leader.”
